

## WEAVERFEST 2007 HAPPY DAYS BBQ COOK OFF RULES

Saturday October 27, Th • 11am – 5pm

Weaverville Primary School Ball Field • Main Street

Weaverville, North Carolina

1. All cooking spaces are first come first serve. *Cook Off for Sponsorship money and Trophies.*
2. BOOTH SPACE 20X20 \$50. Larger sites are available for additional \$25. Deadline for Registration October 20<sup>th</sup>, 2007.
3. Friday, October 26<sup>th</sup> 2007 each team must be checked in no earlier than 4:30 p.m. and no later than 6 p.m. on Friday. Cook meeting at 7:30 p.m. Friday.
4. Teams will be permitted to begin setting up their equipment anytime after arrival.
5. Each team shall provide all other equipment, and other supplies needed. Each team will provide its own tent, canopy. Teams must have containers to carry and hold water, equipment for sanitation and containers for holding food at the required temperature for public consumption. Meat must be cooked on site. Sanitation (wash, rinse, disinfect) will be checked, Proper storage of meat is required -- It must be maintained below 40F or above 140F. Internal temperature should reach 155 degrees sometime during the cooking process. Proper handling of food is required.
6. Decorating your site with streamers, banners, flags, signs etc. is encouraged but not required. Trash should be removed regularly. Upon departure sight should be left as you found it.
7. All teams are required to respect the rights of all other teams and neighboring homes with a special emphasis from each team relating to music, loud or profane language or infringement on adjoining site with any equipment, coolers etc The chief cook will be responsible for the conduct of his/her team and guest. Our desire is for you to have a relaxed enjoyable time.
8. **This event is being held in the city limits close to homes of Weaverville and on Buncombe County School property. Consumption of any alcoholic beverages or substance of any kind will not be permitted.** The emphasis of this event is on family, community and good clean family fun.
9. Weaverfest reserves the right to make additional rules and regulations as the situation warrants. Decisions by the committee/coordinator are final.
10. The event is Peoples Choice pulled pork only. Some of the meat (Boston butts) is being provided by Food Lion, vendors are asked to bring 4 additional (approx 8 oz. Ea Boston butts) and any additional meat you would wish to prepare for sampling. 2 oz. Sampling containers will be provided. No food or drinks are permitted to be sold by contestants. This event is a not for profit fundraiser and permits are not required. Tickets will be sold at the gate along with a plate for the public to choose which BBQ they would wish after sampling. No more than one sample per person please.
11. Wood, Charcoal and Gas cookers are permitted. Drip pans must be used to catch grease. Note: All food will be cooked in above ground cookers. Any food found to be "NOT Done" will be asked to be removed from serving area. No charcoal or wood embers are to be emptied on the ground or in trash receptacles. NO OPEN FIRES.
12. Rest Rooms are provided. If tents or campers are brought in please be advised we have no dumping stations, electrical or water for your campers. All roads must be open and passable.
13. Weaverfest, its sponsors and volunteers shall not be responsible or liable for the property of any team, any loss, damage or injury occurring to any team or its representatives. All property of the teams shall be under care, custody and control of the team, whether in transit to, from or within the cook off.
